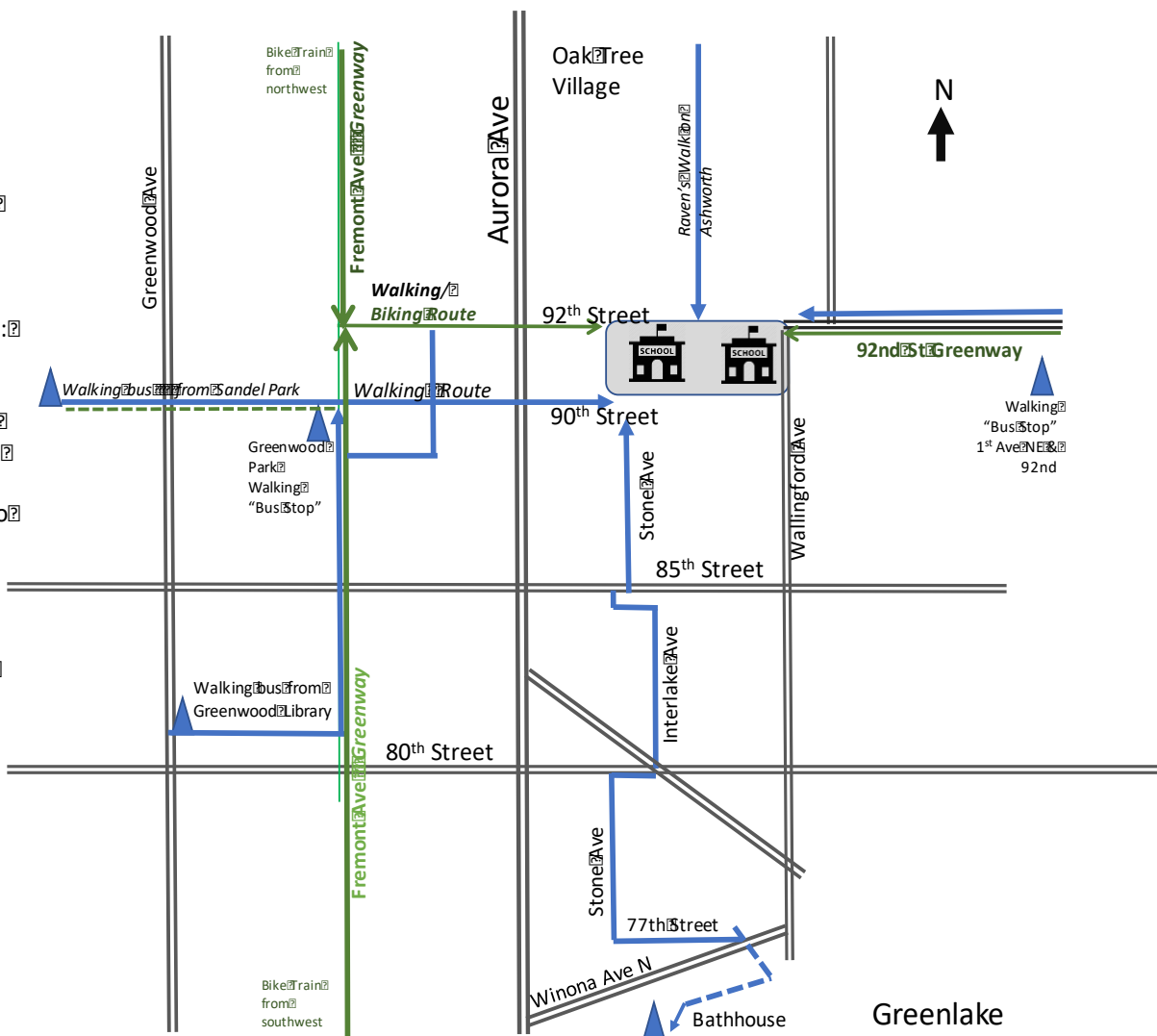


## Walking Buses and nearby approaches. WORKING DRAFT- USE WITH CAUTION

### NOTES

- Walking bus from Greenwood Library goes east on 81<sup>st</sup>, then north on Fremont, and either 89<sup>th</sup> to Linden and then 90<sup>th</sup> or to 92<sup>nd</sup>.
- Walking bus from Sandel Park goes east on 90<sup>th</sup> (caution: sidewalks near Fremont and 90<sup>th</sup>).
- Caution crossing Aurora @ 90<sup>th</sup> – suggest cross on north side to avoid cars turning left to southbound from 90<sup>th</sup>.
- Biking: Greenway on Fremont, then 92<sup>nd</sup>, bikes follow to new signal at 92<sup>nd</sup> and Aurora.
- Caution crossing Aurora at all times.
- From south, use signal at Interlaken/80<sup>th</sup> then go north and cross 85<sup>th</sup> at signal at Stone Way. Good meeting point is Bathhouse/Greenlake Park.
- From east, use 92<sup>nd</sup> bridge w/ bike lane across I-5.
- Caution entering school campus across bus lanes on Stone and busy 90<sup>th</sup> arterial.
- Put devices in pockets while crossing streets. Pay attention. Be visible.



## How to Help Keep Kids Safe

- **Assist with crossings**, using flags to help kids cross the street before and after school. Sign up in office.

- **Walk to/from the bus stops** in the neighborhood. This supports safe behaviors and makes kids more visible.
- **Advocate** for safer routes and crossing guards. While SDOT has some plans, many parents are still concerned about some routes, such as 90<sup>th</sup> & Stone.
