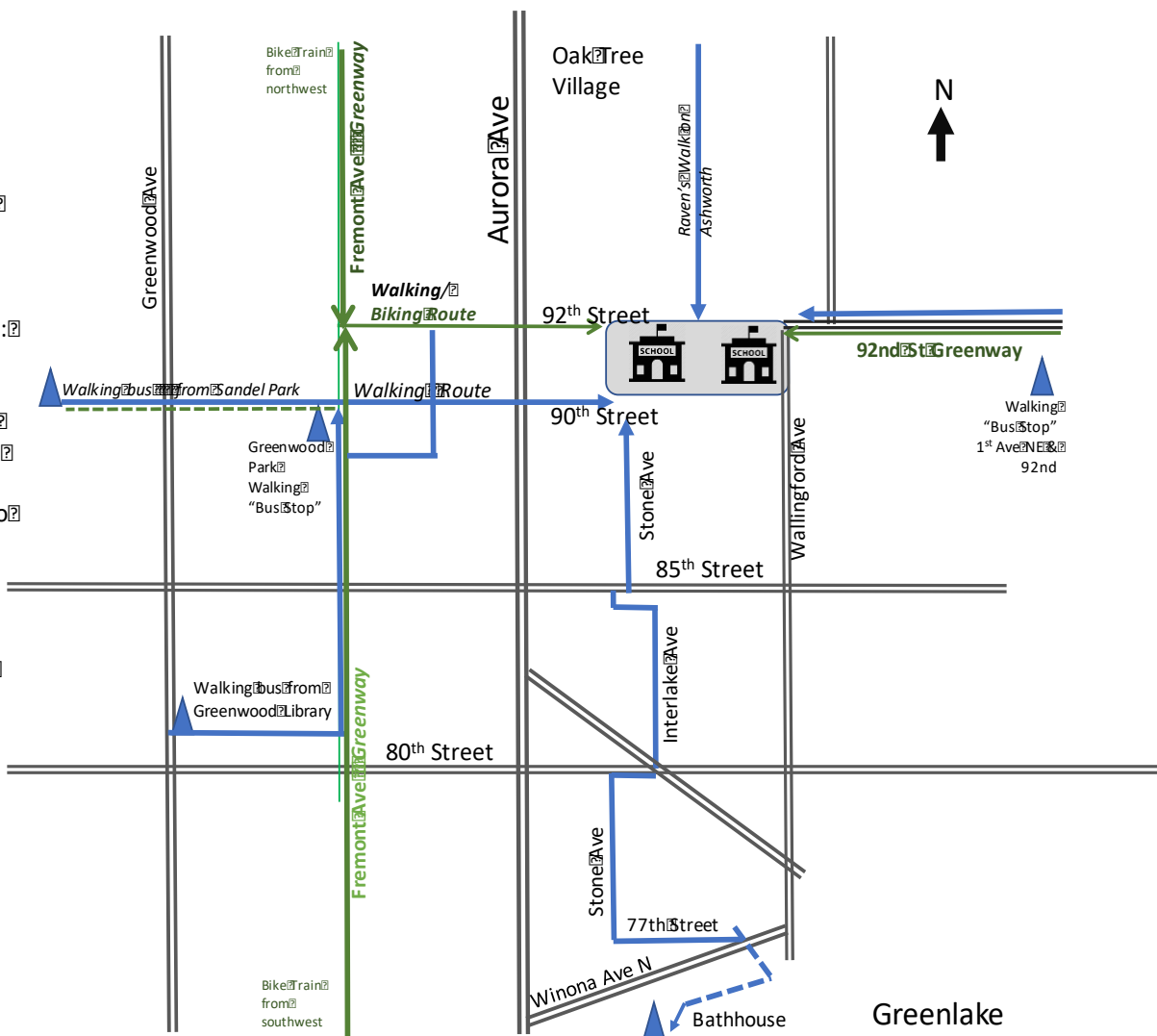


Walking Buses and Nearby Approaches. WORKING DRAFT- USE WITH CAUTION

NOTES

- Walking bus from Greenwood Library goes east on 81st, then north on Fremont, and either 89th to Linden and then 90th or to 92nd.
- Walking bus from Sandel Park goes east on 90th (caution: sidewalks near Fremont and 90th).
- Caution crossing Aurora @ 90th – suggest cross on north side to avoid cars turning left to southbound from 90th.
- Biking: Greenway on Fremont, then 92nd, bikes follow to new signal at 92nd and Aurora.
- Caution crossing Aurora at all times.
- From south, use signal at Interlaken/80th then go north and cross 85th at signal at Stone Way. Good meeting point is Bathhouse/Greenlake Park.
- From east, use 92nd bridge w/ bike lane across I-5.
- Caution entering school campus across bus lanes on Stone and busy 90th arterial.
- Put devices in pockets while crossing streets. Pay attention. Be visible.



How to Help Keep Kids Safe

- **Assist with crossings**, using flags to help kids cross the street before and after school. Sign up in office.

- **Walk to/from the bus stops** in the neighborhood. This supports safe behaviors and makes kids more visible.
- **Advocate** for safer routes and crossing guards. While SDOT has some plans, many parents are still concerned about some routes, such as 90th & Stone.
